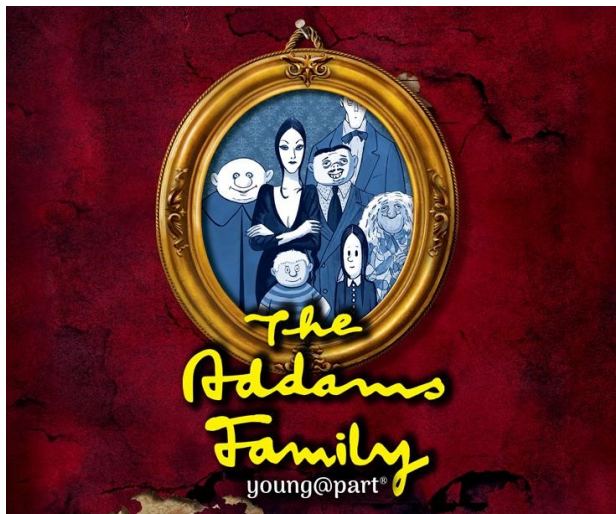

## Director's Note

Dear TCS Family,

It has been a wonderful summer full of discovery and imagination. I am tremendously fortunate to have worked on this production with our production team and with such support from so many of you in the community. I am honored to be working with such talented and hardworking students and staff. *The Addams Family* represents the invisible borders that exist in our society and world between groups that paint one another as monsters. 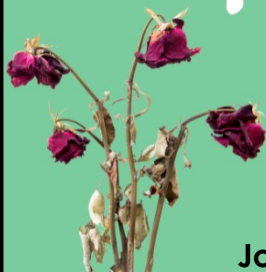
