Acting Coach's Note

If I'm honest, I spent a lot of high school with plastic level social status, and zero awareness of my impact. I don't know that I ever had to fight for my place, probably hurt some people, and in the wake of it had a lot of regrets. I spent a lot of the years to follow earning a chance to live out the message of this show, which I firmly believe is "be unapologetically yourself, and the right people will love you and meet you there". The lessons I learned about empowering others have shaped me into a much more selfless person. I had convinced myself high school was not like this musical in real life, because of my lived experience, but in reality, I think a lot of kids today feel much more of these things than I did as a high schooler.

The *Mean Girls* movie (the real one, with Lindsay and Rachel...) had a profound impact on my generation, and earned its way into my heart right away. The musical was NEW to me when I accepted this position and I have learned to love and appreciate it because of what these kids here at TCS have taught me along the way. Upon asking some of them what they want our audience to walk away feeling, their answers have been profound. They've keyed in on the value of being authentic, owning your "other-ness", and having empathy for others.

When we decided we were moving to Massachusetts last fall, I noticed my "place in the food chain" be altered. Going from being the expert in my department who mentors new teachers, to being one of the newest people in a school was a big shift socially for me. I finally feel a little of the meaning behind this musical. I have been faced with (for the first time, really) finding my way in a new social setting. Boston is definitely a new habitat when compared to Seattle! TCS has welcomed me with open arms, though, which reminds me of the true reason I loved theatre in the first place; everyone belongs. The jocks, the brains, the band kids (at the risk of sounding like John Bender, wrong movie) all of us want the same thing, to feel like we belong.

My experience in the last decade as an educator, a teacher and director of theatre arts, and as a coach for young people has taught me many things, but perhaps most importantly the message the musical *Mean Girls* begs to remind us all of, when people feel free to be authentically themselves, that is where they truly shine. As we watch Norbury push Cady to remember who she is here in this musical, I hope we can all take to heart the gift of live theatre, and the opportunity it brings—to help us hear other stories, and build our empathy. For that is something the world can use a little more of.

I am eternally grateful to the team here: the board, producers, technical team, creative team, volunteers, cast, and crew for all of their efforts. The Youth Theatre Workshop would not be this successful without each and every one of them. If you see our production and think to yourself, "I know someone who should be doing this and belongs here," I strongly encourage you to empower them to get involved and help grow our community. Just like with empathy, more is always better!

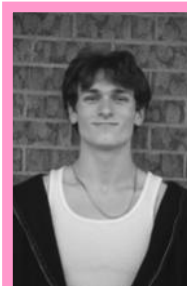
Cast

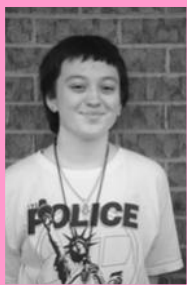
thankful to be a part of this production and to have been an Intern for TCS for *Roald Dahl's Matilda: The Musical, Jr.* and hopes you enjoy the show!

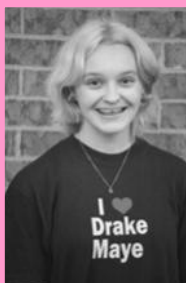
